### Small Firm (< 99) Member, \$100/year

- Employed by a firm or for profit organization that employs between 1 and 99 employees (refers to firm size, not office size)

### Solo Practice/Government/Non-Profit Member: \$75/year

- Solo Practice
- Employed by a local or federal government
- Employed by a non-profit
- Attorneys who are unemployed

### Associate Member: \$125/year

- J.D. degree, but not admitted to practice in the United States
- Non-lawyer related to the legal profession or interested in supporting the WBA mission
- May not vote or hold WBA office.

### Law Student Member: \$30/year

- Currently enrolled in law school.
- May not vote or hold WBA office.

### Judicial Member: Complimentary

- Member of the Judiciary.
- Eligible to vote if admitted to a bar in the United States.
